

Gift Aid was established to increase charitable giving in the UK. Provided that you are a UK taxpayer, we can claim from Inland Revenue the basic rate tax paid on your gift, boosting your donation by 25%. So a gift of £10 is worth £12.50 to children in Colombia!

Notes

- 1. In order for your donation to qualify under the Gift Aid scheme you must ensure that you pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax, in a year, equal or greater than the amount of tax that the charity will be able to reclaim on your donation (25p currently, for every £1 donated).
- 2. Your home address must be given.
- 3. You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying us it will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of cancellation or such later date as you specify.
- 4. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that Children Change Colombia reclaims, you can cancel your declaration.
- 5. If you pay Income Tax at the higher or additional rate and want to receive the additional tax relief due to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self-Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue and Customs to adjust your tax code.
- 6. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask your local UK tax office for leaflet IR113 Gift Aid.
- 7. Please notify Children Change Colombia if you change your name or address.
